6. Navigate to your Downloads folder and select the downloaded file. (This is a temporary file and can be deleted after successful import to *Endnote*.) Select *Reference Manager (RIS)* in the *Import Options* drop-down list. This option relates to the format of the downloaded citation file. From other providers, such as *worldcat.org*, or Morling's *Liberty* Library Catalogue, you may need to select the *Endnote Import* option. Sometimes trial-and-error is the only way to find out the correct option here. Click *Import* to activate the import.
