Ebooks

Revised November 2020

The merger of Vose with Morling brings the ebook holdings of two colleges to all our students. We now provide access to about 500,000 ebooks. As a library member, you can access ebooks from anywhere you have an internet connection. Most titles can be read at the same time as other users, eliminating the frustration of the books you need being on loan. We offer ebooks from four platforms (Ebook Central, EBSCO, Perlego, and Wheelers) as well as links to free ebooks from the internet. The reason for the multiple platforms is that no single platform offers titles from all publishers.

The list of titles is generated automatically by publisher and price, and so contains a wide range of ebooks, some of them surprising or obscure. Unfortunately, publishers have restricted these titles to 1 user at a time only for each copy purchased.
