1. Print (in Library Journal Room), request an article to be scanned and emailed to you by emailing the library staff at library@morling.edu.au
2. Databases: EBSCO and ProQuest
3. Other journals the Library subscribes to
4. Ebooks: Accessed via the EBSCO database platform
